**John Naylor** was a chorister at Durham and a scholar at Rossall School. He was a choral scholar at St John's College, Cambridge and trained with the great Dr George Guest. He subsequently became a member of the choir at the Chapel Royal of St Peter ad Vincula, and of The Louis Halsey Singers, The Monteverdi Choir and was a founder member of the chorus of the Academy of St Martin in the Fields. He has sung in the cathedral choirs of Christ Church Oxford, Carlisle and Chester cathedrals.

John is Music Director of Nantwich Choral Society and The Lydian Singers and he also conducts The Open University Chapel Choir. He has conducted choirs in most of the cathedrals in this country and is one of the region's most experienced choral directors. He is particularly noted for his friendly encouragement of singers of all ages and all abilities.

**Simon Russell** is a former Organ Scholar of St Catherine's College Cambridge and Assistant Organist of Chester Cathedral. He is Regional Manager for the RSCM in Central and East England. Simon is currently Organist at St Mary's Nantwich and is the regular accompanist for NCS.

### Repertoire

After such a long time of choral silence during the Covid 19 Pandemic this event will provide an early opportunity for singers to sing together once again in a purposeful but informal event based in one of Cheshire's most beautiful churches.

The day will represent a great opportunity for singers of all abilities to make or renew their acquaintance with some the greatest European sacred choral music ever written in singing sessions which will be informative but relaxed and enjoyable for all.

No apology is made for the fact that most of the repertoire will be familiar to previous attenders of NCS Singing Days: we hope that singers will enjoy the opportunity to sing many much-loved choral masterpieces once again.

The repertoire will include music by Bruckner, Franck, Faure, Mendelssohn, Mozart, Palestrina, Rachmaninov, Rheinberger and Victoria.
